You are eligible to enroll in Health Net Violet 2 (PPO) if:

- You are entitled to Medicare Part A and enrolled in Medicare Part B. Members must continue to pay their Medicare Part B premium if not otherwise paid for under Medicaid or by another third party.
- You must be a United States citizen, or are lawfully present in the United States and permanently reside in the service area of the plan (in other words, your permanent residence is within the Health Net Violet 2 (PPO) service area counties). Our service area includes the following counties in Oregon and Washington: Benton, Clackamas, Lane, Linn, Marion, Multnomah, Polk, Washington and Yamhill, OR; Clark County, WA.

With Health Net Violet 2 (PPO) plan, you'll enjoy the freedom and flexibility to access your health care where you want it and when you want it. You may seek care from any Medicare provider in the country who agrees to see you as a Medicare member, but you'll generally pay less when you use contracting providers in our network. Either way, doctor visits, hospital stays and many other services have a simple copayment, which helps make health care costs more predictable.

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Part D Prescription Drugs

Deductible Stage	<p>\$150 deductible for Part D prescription drugs (applies to drugs on Tiers 3, 4 and 5).</p> <p>The Deductible Stage is the first payment stage for your drug coverage. This stage begins when you fill your first prescription in the year. When you are in this payment stage, you must pay the full cost of your Part D drugs until you reach the plan's deductible amount.</p> <p>Once you have paid the plan's deductible amount for your Part D drugs, you leave the Deductible Stage and move on to the next payment stage (Initial Coverage Stage).</p>		
Initial Coverage Stage (after you pay your Part D deductible, if applicable)	<p>After you have met your deductible (if applicable), the plan pays its share of the cost of your drugs and you pay your share of the cost. You generally stay in this stage until the amount of your year-to-date "total drug costs" reaches \$4,130. "Total drug costs" is the total of all payments made for your covered Part D drugs. It includes what the plan pays, what you pay. Once your "total drug costs" reach \$4,130 you move to the next payment stage (Coverage Gap Stage).</p>

Coverage Gap Stage	<p>During this payment stage, you receive a 70% manufacturer's discount on covered brand name drugs and the plan will cover another 5%, so you will pay 25% of the negotiated price and a portion of the dispensing fee on brand-name drugs. In addition the plan will pay 75% and you pay 25% for generic drugs. (The amount paid by the plan does not count towards your out-of-pocket costs.)</p> <p>You generally stay in this stage until the amount of your year-to-date "out-of-pocket costs" reaches \$6,550. "Out of pocket costs" includes what you pay when you fill or refill a prescription for a covered Part D drug and payments made for your drugs by any of the following programs or organizations: "Extra Help" from Medicare; Medicare's Coverage Gap Discount Program; Indian Health Service; AIDS drug assistance programs; most charities; and most State Pharmaceutical Assistance Programs (SPAPs). Once your "out-of-pocket costs" reach \$6,550, you move to the next payment stage (Catastrophic Coverage Stage).</p>		

Part D Prescription Drugs

Catastrophic Coverage Stage

During this payment stage, the plan pays most of the cost for your covered drugs. For each prescription, you pay whichever of these is greater: a payment equal to 5% coinsurance of the drug, or a copayment (\$3.70 for a generic drug or a drug that is treated like a generic, \$9.20 for all other drugs).

Important Info:

Cost-sharing may change depending on the pharmacy you choose (such as Preferred Retail, Standard Retail, Mail Order, Long-Term Care, or Home Infusion) and when you enter any of the four stages of the Part D benefit.
